Dr. William A. Brown of Easton passed away after a long illness May 11th 2005 at the Talbot Hospice House. He was 79.

Born in Winchester, VA August 4th, 1925, he was the son of the late Lee Albert and Marguerite Wisecarver Brown. He graduated from Handley High School and served in the U.S. Coast Guard during WWII. He attended the University of Virginia and in 1951 graduated with a Doctorate of Chiropractic degree. He practiced in Easton for many years.

Bill enjoyed fishing, traveling and researching Civil War history. At the time of his death he was working on a book about the Civil War. He was a member of the Eastern Shore Writer's Guild.

Dr. Brown is survived by his wife of 57 years, the former Isabel L. Larrick. They were married in Winchester in July 1948; a daughter, Elizabeth Blair Blizzard of Easton, and two grand children, Christopher and Caleigh Blizzard. He was preceded in death by his brother, Lawrence Brown.

Private interment will be at the Oxford Cemetery in Oxford, MD.
