Dulica Mildred Hergenrather of Stevensville, MD died Thursday, May 27, 2004 at Corsica Hills Nursing Home, Centreville, MD. She was 85.

Born on June 17, 1918 in Camden, NJ, she was the daughter of the late John W. Anderson and Mary A. Kane. She attended high school in Akron, OH. She moved to Baltimore, MD and met her husband, Joseph Ford Hergenrather and they were married May 19, 1943. During World War II, she worked for Bendix in communication assembly (a Rosie the Riveter) and later graduated from St. Joseph's Nursing Academy in Baltimore, MD. She then lived in Dundalk, MD until 1965 when they moved to Claymont, DE. In 1978, they moved to Stevensville, MD.

She was a member of St. Christopher's Catholic Church and past member of Island Idlers. She enjoyed her family, sewing and gardening.

Mrs. Hergenrather is survived by two sons, Joseph John Hergenrather of Stevensville, MD and Michael David Hergenrather of Claymont, DE; one daughter, Louise Shafer of Lawrenceville, GA and two grandchildren.
