



E. Christina Hollingshead

November 30, 1940 - August 14, 2012

Christina Hollingshead, formerly of Joppatowne, MD, died on Tuesday, August 14, 2012, at Memorial Hospital at Easton surrounded by her loving family. She was 71.

Born November 30, 1940 in Baltimore, she was the daughter of the late, James Alexander and Edna Holm Kofskey. After attending Sparrows Point High School, she graduated from Towson State Teacher's College in 1962, and then went on to complete her Master's Degree at Morgan State College. Mrs. Hollingshead taught elementary education for 35 years at Deerfield Elementary School in Edgewood, MD, where she received "The Teacher In Charge" achievement award. After retiring, she and her family moved to Easton where she was a member of the Women's Guild at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church.

She is survived by her daughter, Elizabeth Diane Chatham; her son-in-law, Timothy; her grandson, the love of her life, Jacob Alexander Hollingshead, who referred to her as the one and only "Busha"; a brother, James Kofskey of Brea, CA.; and several nieces and nephews from Pennsylvania, Maryland, Indiana, California, and Alabama.

Along with her parents, she is predeceased by her loving husband, Walter Daniel Hollingshead, whom she married on June 24, 1961. They began dating

at the age of 15 and were married for 42 years. She is also predeceased by a daughter, Catherine Jeanne Hollingshead.

A funeral service will be held on Sunday, August 19, 2012, at 1 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, where friends may call on Saturday, August 18 from 2 to 4 p.m.

Burial will be private.
