



E. Rodman Wolff

May 21, 1914 - November 8, 2013

E. Rodman Wolff, formally of Easton, MD, died at home on November 8, 2013. He was 99.

Born in Secretary, MD, May 21, 1914, he was the son of the late Otto and Elizabeth Ross Wolff. After graduating from Vienna High School in 1932, he drove a truck for Preston Trucking Company. In 1947, he moved to Easton where he became Parts Manager for Elliott Equipment Company, a position he held until retiring in May of 1979 with 32 years of service. He then worked part-time for the company in inventory control for the next fifteen years.

He was a member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton for many years, and current member of Berlin-Ocean City Lighthouse Church of God. He served as an Assistant Scoutmaster for Troop 177, Boy Scouts of America, for several years. His hobbies included fishing and bowling; and he was also a member of the Tidewater Stamp Club.

Mr. Wolff is survived by a son, H. Rodman Wolff and his wife The Rev. Joan C. Wolff of Easton; a daughter, The Rev. Nancy W. Soulsman and her husband Bishop Ronald H. Soulsman of Ocean City; three grandchildren, Brad A. Soulsman (Pam) of Ocean City, Sara W. Lewis (Brian) of Delmar, MD, and Becky S. Lynch (Doug) of Delmar, DE; and four great-grandchildren, Madison R. Soulsman, Morgan A. Soulsman, Brook L. Lynch and Adam D. Lynch.

He is preceded in death by his wife of 66 years, Mary Ruth Marshall; sisters, Angeline W. Simmons, Maurel W. Drennen, Marie W. Quaintance and Virginia W. Hibberd; and a brother, Erman Wilson Wolff.
