



Earl Russell Archer Jr.

October 17, 1940 - June 20, 2013

Earl Russell Archer, Jr., 72, of Stevensville, MD, died at Heritage Harbour Health and Rehabilitation Center on June 20, 2013.

Born in Potomac, MD, on October 17, 1940, he was the son of the late Earl Russell Archer, Sr., and Tessiel Hamilton. Earl grew up in the Rockville area and was a graduate of Richard Montgomery High School. After graduation, he began his apprenticeship with the local plumbing union, and retired as a plumber after 50 years with the Plumbers and Gas Fitters Local #5. Earl loved all things automotive, including racing, truck pulling, and restoring vintage automobiles, as well as traveling and camping, and spending time with his family.

He is survived by his wife, Linda Howell Archer; his children, Russell B. Archer of Harmony, MD, Glenda L. Denny and her husband, Randy, of Chestertown, MD, and Daniel B.
