Earl M. Wheatley, Jr., passed away peacefully on Sunday, December 7, 2014, surrounded by his loving family. He was 83 years old.

Born on March 23, 1931, in Cambridge, MD, he was the son of the late Earl Mitchell Wheatley, Sr., and Mildred Mayne Wheatley.

After graduating from high school, he served in the United States Air Force. Mr. Wheatley lived most of his life in Oxford, a town which he loved dearly. He worked most of his life as an electrician on boats and also a builder of boats. He loved the water, sailing to many locations, from Maine to Florida. He was a life member of the Oxford Fire Company. He was a dear friend to all who knew him -- a loving husband, father and grandfather.

Mr. Wheatley is survived by his loving wife of 61 years, the former Joanne Pope of Oxford; his four children, Stephany Allendorf (Steve) of Preston, Mitchell Wheatley (Darlene) of Easton, Karyn Wheatley of Toddville, and Skip Wheatley (Lisa) of Cockeysville; a brother; Kenneth M. Wheatley of Cambridge; ten grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren.

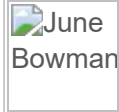
