Earl C. "Tody" Coleman of Trappe, MD died Monday, September 24, 2001 at the home of his niece, Rosalie Price. He was 89.

Born May 27, 1912 in Windy Hill, he was the son of the late Howard Lee, Sr. and Clara Skipper Coleman. He attended Talbot County Public Schools and worked as a farmer, waterman and caretaker. He was an avid hunter and outdoorsman.

A lifelong resident of the Trappe area, he was a member of the Trappe United Methodist Church and the United Methodist Men's Association. A life member of the Trappe Vol. Fire Company since 1962, he was awarded a Governor's Citation in 1996 from Governor Glendening for 55 years of service.

Mr. Coleman is survived by his wife, the former Frances Annalee Wheatley whom he married December 11, 1934; one daughter, Ellen C. Whitby of Trappe; three sisters, Rebecca Cheezum of Cambridge, Virginia Hurley of Princes Anne and Etta Bainbridge of Rockton, IL; three brothers, Carroll Coleman of Bruceville, William Coleman and Elmer Coleman of Rockton, IL; three grandchildren, James A.
