Earle B. Ford of Millington, MD died at his home on Sunday, May 8, 2005. He was 89.

Born in Black's, MD, he was the son of the late, Ernest and Mary Warner Ford. Mr. Ford farmed for most of his working career and retired from farming in 1971.

For many years Mr. Ford loved flying his own plane until an illness forced him to sell the plane and stop a hobby he loved. He also loved to travel, play cards and dance.

He was a former member of the Harrington, DE Moose Lodge, and a Social member of the VFW Post 652, Millington, MD. Mr. Ford was probably best known for his ability to tell a story and offer a quick joke or friendly comeback.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Ford is preceded in death by his wife, Marjorie Ford who died in 1993.

Mr. Ford is survived by two sons, Earle F. Ford of Millington, MD and Joseph Ford of Clayton, DE; three Grandchildren and six great grandchildren.
