Earl E. "Sleepy" Lewis of Ridgely, MD died on Monday, November 18, 2002 at Peninsula Regional Medical Center, Salisbury, MD. He was 80.

Born August 17, 1922 in Hooper's Island, MD, he was the son of the late Julian and Bessie Lewis. After attending Dorchester County Public Schools he joined the United States Navy in 1941, during which time he served on the SS Winston-Salem, a Merchant Marine Ship that was torpedoed in the North Atlantic. After his release from active duty in 1946 he attended the Maryland State Police Academy and from 1951 to 1967 he was assigned to the Salisbury Barrack in Worchester County.

He enjoyed flying and in 1964 earned his pilot's license.

He was a member of St. Paul's United Methodist Church in Greensboro, MD.

Mr. Lewis is survived by his wife, the former Patricia A. Hughes, whom he married June 14, 1978; two children, Thomas E. Lewis of Rehoboth Beach, DE and Ann H. Yowell of Petaluma, CA; one sister, Peggy Layton of Delmar, DE; three grandchildren, Logan Lewis, Ryan Yowell and Drew Yowell and a special friend, Dee Anne Blades.

St. Paul's United Methodist Church, Greensboro, MD where friends may call one hour prior to the service.
