Earnest Gregory Gerdom, Jr., 72, of Chestertown, MD, passed away on March 4, 2015. Born in Havre de Grace, on December 11, 1942, he was the son of Muriel (Thompson) and the late Earnest Gerdom, Sr.

Earnie graduated from Havre de Grace High School in 1960. He served in the United States Army in the early 1960's as a Chaplain's assistant; and most notable of the occupations in his career, he was the owner and proprietor of the Maryland Hotel in Betterton, for more than three decades. He was an accomplished cook and was well-known for many signature drinks and dishes including Brandy Alexanders, Manhattan clam chowder, and homemade Boston cream pie.

He is survived by his longtime friend, Dennis Keim of Chestertown; his mother, Muriel Gerdom of Bel Air; three sisters, Joyce Blake and Muriel Greenland of Bel Air, and Barbara Shue of Churchville; seven nieces and nephews; twelve great-nieces and -nephews; and two great-great-nephews.
