Edith Jane Beglin, loving wife, mother, grandmother, sister, aunt, and friend, died on Monday, July 1, 2019, in Oxford, MD. She was 71 years old.

She was born on July 28, 1947, in Beaver Falls, PA, the daughter of the late Joseph S. and Frances Mae Stone Early.

She married Bruce Wayne Beglin on June 14, 1969 in Beaver, PA, where they made their home, before moving to Oxford, MD in 2012.
