Edith Frances Landon of Rock Hall, MD died on May 7, 2026, at Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. She was 92.

She was born on November 9, 1933, the daughter of the late Russell and Virginia Kendall Reynolds. Educated in Rock Hall, she learned the value of industrious work at a young age. Immediately after school she worked in the restaurant industry at the Rock Hall Movie Hall as a “bouncer”, at Tru-Value Hardware, the Rock Hall Shirt Factory, and the bowling alley all in Rock Hall. She married Calvin Landon and they moved to Hawaii and then Virginia before returning to her beloved Rock Hall, MD.

She started the Rock Hall Snack Bar which she owned and operated for 25 years.

She was a member of the Sgt. Preston Ashley American Legion Post #228 Ladies Auxiliary in Rock Hall, MD.

She is survived by two sons Russell P. “Rusty” Mench of Rock Hall, MD and Brian E. Mench of Newark, DE along with 6 grandchildren and 5 great grandchildren.
