Edith B. Price was born in Chester, MD, the daughter of the late Kennard P. Harris and Dora E. Foebus Harris. Edith graduated from Stevensville High School in 1933.

She began working at Fisherman's Inn as a cleaning girl. In 1936, she married John W. Price (deceased 1976) and became a farmer's wife and help-mate. They farmed and lived just outside the town of Stevensville.

They left the farm in the 50's, and she began working as a waitress and hostess at Old Cove Restaurant (formerly Shamrock Inn) on Shamrock Road in Chester. Later she took the position of manager of Kentmorr Restaurant down Route 8. Thinking of the future, in 1996, Edith became a toll collector on the Chesapeake Bay Bridge (now the William Preston Lane Bridge), retiring as Sergeant in 1979. She did work some part-time jobs after retiring.

Edith Price gave birth to two children, Peggy Price Stubbs and John W. Price, Jr. She had four grandchildren, Roger R. Subbs, Jimmy J. Stubbs (deceased), Jimmy W. Price, and Wanda Garner; six great-grandchildren, Amanda Stubbs, James Stubbs, Charlie Stubbs, Elizabeth Stubbs, Ashlee Price, and Joshua Price; two siblings, Eunice H. Chance (deceased) and Jeanne H. Burns (deceased).

Mrs. Price is a member of the Maryland Classified Association, the Stevensville High School Alumni Association and the Red Hat Sassy Chix.
