July 5, 1949 - April 19, 2018

Edith Ann "Edie" Stevens of Worton, MD, passed away on Thursday, April 19, 2018, at Compass Regional Hospice in Centreville. She was 68.

Born on July 5, 1949, in Georgetown, MD, she was the daughter of the late George Noble Dixon, Sr., and Ruth Redding Dixon. Edie graduated in 1967 from Galena High School. She worked at Buzz's Restaurant for eight years and later worked as Food Service Manager for Washington College. While working with Buzz's Restaurant, she met Hall of Fame baseball player Brooks Robinson, and became lifelong friends. She was a member of Christ I.U. Church in Worton, the Community Marching Band, Soroptimist of Kent County, Notary, and the Galena Band.

Edie enjoyed gardening, dancing, crocheting, making crafts, and spending time with her family and friends, especially her grandchildren.

She is survived by a son, John "Jay" Callahan and his wife Linda of Chestertown, MD; a daughter; Wendy McNamee and husband Edd of Garner, NC; a sister, Mary Lee Bennett of Chestertown, MD; grandchildren, Johnathan Callahan, Crystal Callahan, Melissa Callahan, Meghan McNamee and Ryan McNamee; along with her great-granddaughter, Tenley Jayne Callahan.

I enjoyed sitting with her on her couch listening to her stories about raising her baby squirrels or talking about her precious dog named Kallie and how she’d adopted her from The Humane Society of Kent County.

Edie loved to watch her soap operas or the Hallmark channel and whenever I’d visit with her they’d be playing on TV in the background. We both have a love of old antiques and we’d often talk about the pretty Pyrex bowls and cast iron pans that we both liked to collect.

Our biggest bond was probably her dog Kallie. She loved that sweet dog so much and took her everywhere with her. Whenever I rode in Edie’s car it was in the back seat because Kallie had her own special car seat right up front next to Edie! My daughter knew how much that dog meant to Miss Edie so she painted a portrait of Kallie for Edie when she passed away last year.

There are so many wonderful memories that I have of Edie and most of them have to do with the yummy food that she loved to prepare for people. But one of the days that means the most to me was about a year and a half ago when we got back from a doctor appointment. He told her that she didn't have much time left. We sat on her couch holding hands, drinking some wine, and we both started to cry. After a bit she said, "You know Cri, I've had a really good life. I'll be OK." And from that day on we just laughed, loved and took each day as it came. We kept her days as close to her regular schedule as possible and didn't let her prognosis stop her from enjoying her friends and her life. 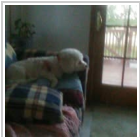
