Edithanne Heed Paxson, 93, of Bayleigh Chase (formerly William Hill Manor) in Easton, MD, died peacefully on August 2, 2016.

A native of West Chester, PA, daughter of the late Warren D. and Abbie Y Heed, and a 1941 graduate of West Chester High School, she attended Pierce Business College and formerly worked for the Pennsylvania Railroad, Hercules Powder Company, and West Chester University. In West Chester, she was a member of the First Presbyterian Church and the New Century Club.

She resided for many years in Timonium, MD, active as a homemaker and in community affairs. She was a member of Trinity Episcopal Church in Towson where she served on the Altar Guild and at the Surprise Shop, and also served the Baltimore Meals on Wheels program. In later years she attended St. Stephen's Anglican Church in Timonium, MD.

In 2011, she moved to Easton, MD where she made many new friends, loved playing bridge, and was so wonderfully cared for by the loving staff at Bayleigh Chase.

She is survived by two sons, Francis C. Dudley Jr. (Maddalena) of Colleyville, TX, and Philip H. Dudley (Susan) of Cumming, GA; two daughters, Julie

Dudley Halteman (Ronald) of Telford, PA , and Beth Anne Trippe (Richard) of Easton, MD; two stepsons, David S. Paxson (Patricia) of Conway, SC, and William C. Paxson (Tanya) of Sparks, MD; a stepdaughter, Carol Summers (Ronald) of Newnan GA; 10 grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren. She was predeceased in 2010 by her husband of 48 years, Sharpless M. Paxson. She was also predeceased by her first husband, George Temple, and her first daughter, Patricia Anne Temple.
