Edith Dodd Harrison of Preston, MD died on Wednesday, December 10, 2008 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 83.

Born February 20, 1925, she was the daughter of the late Edward H. and Mary Ellen Utz Dodd. After graduating from Marlboro High School in 1942, she worked as a secretary at the Navy Yard in Annapolis and then for the Prince Georges County Board of Education.

For many years she taught Bible Fellowship Studies at her home. She was an active member of Mt. Oak Methodist Church in Mitchellville, MD. After moving to the Eastern Shore in 1975, she attended Ridgely United Methodist Church and was a member of First Wesleyan Church of Easton.
