Edith Laws Spann of Easton died on Wednesday, March 7, 2001 at the Memorial Hospital in Easton. She was 86.

Born in Washington, D.C. on December 4, 1914, she was the daughter of the late John Thornley and Annie Hunter Laws. As a resident of the Washington, D.C. area, she received her education there and began working for the C & P Telephone Company, the American Red Cross, and the North Bethesda Church.
