



Edmond Alexander Utkewicz II

January 17, 1957 - June 25, 2025

Edmond Alexander Utkewicz, II (68) of Centreville, MD passed away with his son holding his hand and his family by his side on June 25, 2025, after struggling with a long, painful, and courageous battle with cancer.

At an early age Edmond and his family moved to Centreville, Maryland where he was raised and maintained a small family farm. Edmond attended and graduated from Queen Anne's County High School, class of 1975.

After graduation, Edmond became self employed by owning and operating EuroCar International. He also became a real estate agent/broker. Edmond was the jack-of- all-trades and knew how to fix and tinker with anything. He loved to lend a helping hand to fix or supervise anything that needed to be fixed, without hesitation or cost. Even when he could no longer physically do the job, he would help people over the phone and walk them through how to fix it, from cars, plumbing, or something electrical. There was not anything Edmond could not do.

As an outdoor enthusiast, Edmond enjoyed nature, taking long walks on the beach, and hiking trails. Edmond also enjoyed going to auctions, pawn shops, and yard sales looking for the best deals. In his spare time, he loved to ride horses or to just simply be around them. As his cancer progressed, he loved sitting by the water watching the bald eagles, ospreys, and blue herons. He especially enjoyed the bufflehead ducks as he watched their small energetic

frames dive underwater. He loved all animals and there was not a dog he did not like. As an avid reader, Edmond deeply enjoyed and frequently engaged in books, often reading for personal growth. He was more likely to read books as a source of high-quality entertainment as he was always eager to learn new things.

Edmond also had a deep and passionate interest in automobiles, especially foreign ones. He was not just a casual driver, he had a genuine interest in the mechanics, history, and culture surrounding the automobiles. He had a deep knowledge and appreciation of each vehicle he owned. Edmond frequently participated in car shows, and other events to celebrate his passion for cars. He enjoyed engaging in conversations about cars and comparing different models and engines. He especially enjoyed sharing his expertise and knowledge about cars with his son, Alex, who also became a car enthusiast.

One of his happiest times was when he was with his son, Alex, as he started his own business, Utkewicz Land Management & Excavation. He enjoyed going to various work sites with his son and lending a helping hand before he became too weak from cancer. Nonetheless, each day he could not wait to get that phone call from his son to see how his day was going and what his crew had accomplished.

Edmond was the son of the late Edmond Joseph Utkewicz and the late June Marie Utkewicz. He is survived by his son, Edmond Alexander Utkewicz III (Rachel), two loving grandchildren Gavin and Penny June, sister, Karen Utkewicz Rhodes (Kevin), nephew Nikolai O. Rhodes, and niece Anastasia M. Rhodes. He also leaves behind many close cousins and friends.

The family would like to thank everyone who helped take Edmond back and forth to John Hopkins Cancer Center for his treatment, especially his dear friend, Kevin Dey. May Edmond rest in eternal peace, free from pain, and may

he be remembered for the love and light he brought into the lives of others.

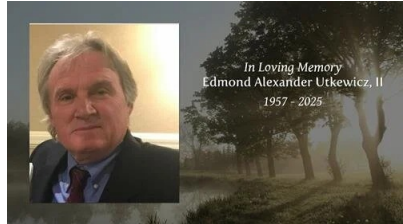

“ My name is Edmond Johnson. Edmond Utkewicz was my first cousin, my mother's brother Edmond's son. Because we were only two months apart we called each other Cousin Edmond. I was Cousin Edmond...he was Cousin Edmond. This is how we and our families referred to each other. I remember when Uncle Edmond told us he had a big surprise, he bought something big. I thought it was an amusement park but it was Tanyard Farm. As kids when we went to Tanyard Farm it was like being Tom Sawyer with Cousin Edmond. I was the city slicker who came to the country. Early on when Aunt June needed a few dozen eggs for breakfast, she would send Cousin Edmond and myself on the tractor to drive up the street to another farm to get the eggs. We were about 12 years old and Cousin Edmond was driving this huge tractor up the road. It was not uncommon for us either to be walking the fields with a 10 or 12 gage shot gun at that age shooting anything that moved. It was exciting. We would ride horses or go carts and always have an adventure. Even going to the 4H Fair. It was always an adventure with Cousin Edmond. I will miss you my Cousin. God love you, Your Cousin Edmond
