Edmund C. Peach, Jr., of 130 Sheaffer Road, Chestertown, MD died early Friday morning, June 20, 2003 at Kent & Queen Anne's Hospital. He was 66.

Born in Baltimore, MD on June 3, 1937 he was raised in Granite, MD. He moved to Philadelphia as a teenager where he met his wife of 43 years, Barbara Lee Cross.

A graduate of St. Joseph's Prep and St. Joseph's College in Philadelphia and an armed-services veteran, Mr. Peach moved with his wife to Carlisle, PA in 1961 to work and there they raised their children. He worked for Masland Carpets in Carlisle for 30 years, completing his career in 1991 as President and CEO of the floor covering division of the company.
