



## Edmund W. Weems

Edmund W. "Woody" Weems of Easton, MD, formerly of Trappe, died on Thursday, September 25, 2003 at William Hill Manor, Easton. He was 82.

Born September 21, 1921 in Shady Side, MD, he was the son of the late Edmund L. and Ida Stiertz Weems. At an early age he and his family moved to the Trappe area of Talbot County. After graduating from Trappe High School in 1938, he attended Cochraut Bryan College in Annapolis. In 1942 he enlisted in the U.S. Army Air Corp where he served as an aerial photographer during World War II. Following his discharge from active duty in 1945, he returned to Trappe where he operated a country store on RT 50 and farmed until 1948. He then, along with his brother, formed Weems Brothers Marine Construction Company where he remained active until his retirement in 1999. The company continues to be owned and operated by his sons and grandsons.

He was a member of the Miles River Power Squadron and the Edge Creek Boat Club. An avid photographer, he also enjoyed boating and working in his garden.

Mr. Weems is survived by two sons, Joseph L. Weems and Steve Weems and his wife Beth all of Trappe; two daughters, Nancy Beatty and her husband Scott of Royal Oak and Karen Hayman of St. Michaels; a sister, Margaret W. Walker of Easton; eight grandchildren; two great grandchildren and numerous

nieces and nephews. His brother and business partner, Robert F. Weems died in 1996.

A memorial service will be held on Monday, September 29, 2003 at 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton.
