December 19, 1939 - June 21, 2014

Edna Lee Howeth of Chestertown, MD, died Saturday, June 21, 2014, at Peninsula Regional Medical Center in Salisbury, MD. She was 74.

Mrs. Howeth was born in Ridgely, MD, the daughter of the late James Lawrence Wright and Ida Virginia Timmons. Mrs. Howeth graduated from Ridgely High School in Ridgely, MD, and was the class Valedictorian. She then graduated from Memorial Hospital School of Nursing. She began her career in nursing as an RN at Easton Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD, where she worked for seven years. She spent her next 43 years working as an Obstetrics Nurse for Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital and retired after a 50-year career in nursing. Mrs. Howeth loved horses and creating artwork. She was a member of First United Methodist Church in Chestertown, MD.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by two brothers, James Lawrence Wright Jr., and Winfield Timmons Wright; and one sister, Ella Mae Wright Kirsch.

She is survived by her husband, Louis Howeth of Chestertown, MD; two sons, Lee Howeth and wife Kerry of Salisbury, MD, and Jamie Howeth and wife Chikage of Austin, TX; four grandchildren, Abigail, Lili, Austen and Zailey; and several nieces and nephews.

A visitation will be held Wednesday, June 25, 2014m from 9 a.m,-10 a.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, 130 Speer Rd Chestertown, MD. Services will begin at 10 a.m. Interment will follow at Denton Cemetery in Denton, MD.

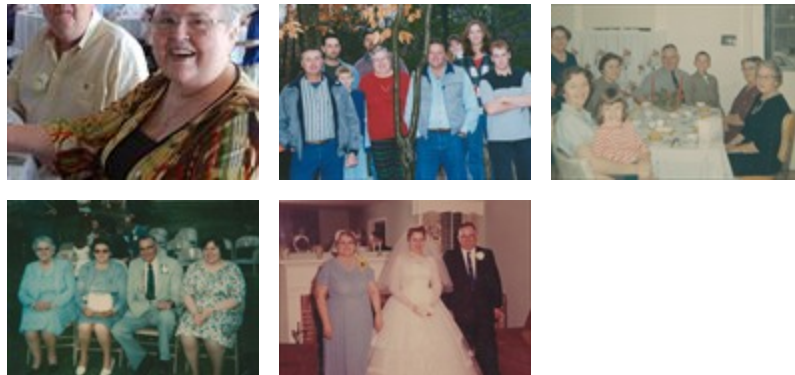
