



Edna A. Duncan

September 14, 1925 - August 19, 2008

Edna Augusta Duncan of Easton, MD passed away peacefully on Tuesday, August 19, 2008 at William Hill Manor, Easton. She was 82.

Born September 14, 1925 in Easton, MD, she was the daughter of the late Walter Weber and Mary Amelia Price Duncan of Oxford. She attended Easton High School, graduating in 1942. She then attended Memorial Hospital School of Nursing, graduating in the Class of 1945. Soon afterwards, she moved to Boston, MA where for 30 years she was employed as office manager and surgical nurse for Dwight E. Harkin, M.D., a renowned cardiac and thoracic surgeon and a pioneer in the development of valvular heart surgery. She traveled worldwide with Dr. Harkin and his cardiac team teaching medical professionals in other countries the surgical relief of mitral stenosis with mitral valve replacement as well as other therapeutic cardiac surgical techniques. She retired in 1996.

After retirement, she made her home in West Windsor, NJ. In 2005, she returned home to be near her family in Oxford and Easton, eventually residing at William Hill Manor. She loved to travel and traveled extensively collecting her prized artifacts from all the countries she visited. She dearly loved her two Shih Tzu pets.

She is survived by three brothers, Russell Weber Duncan, Walter Weber

Duncan, Jr. and Thomas Griffith Duncan, all of Easton; and many nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by two sisters, A. Marguerite Balderson and Florence M. Maxwell.

A graveside service will be held on Saturday, September 6, 2008 at 10:00 AM at Oxford Cemetery, Oxford, MD.
