Edna North Henry of Easton died on Friday, June 24, 2005 at the William Hill Manor, Easton. She was 91.

Born on Tilghman Island on February 24, 1914, she was the daughter of the late Robert Risdon and Effie Tarr North. A lifelong resident of Talbot County she graduated from Easton High School in 1931, then from the Salisbury Normal School and the University of Maryland. Mrs. Henry taught school in Talbot and Caroline Counties retiring in 1977. She also worked as a bookkeeper for her husband John W. Henry III whom she married in 1937, during his years in the farm machinery business. Mr. Henry died in December 1995.

A member of St. Marks United Methodist Church, Easton, where she taught Sunday School, she was also a member of the Delta Kappa Gamma Society, The National Retired Teachers Association, American Association of Retired Persons, the Junior Auxiliary at Memorial Hospital, Easton and Friends of the Talbot Co. Library.

An avid reader, she also enjoyed needlework and gardening.

Mrs. Henry is survived by a son, John W. Henry IV of Annapolis, MD; two daughters, Betty Ann Staton of Salisbury, MD; and Jean H. Smith of Hurlock,

MD; one brother Robert R. North III of Annapolis, MD; and one sister, Eva Hubbard of Easton, MD; nine grandchildren and thirteen great-grandchildren. In addition to her husband, she was predeceased by two brothers Norman North, John Clarence North and a grandson, Michael Staton.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, June 28, 2005 at 3:00PM at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Easton, where friends may call from 1:00 to 3:00PM.

Burial will be in Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton.
