Edward Thomas Balcer of Queenstown, MD, died surrounded by his loving family at the Hospice Center, Centreville, MD, on Sunday, December 18, 2011. He was 86.

Born June 4, 1925, in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late, Thomas and Veronica Golas Balcerowicz. After graduation from high school, he married his neighborhood sweetheart, Olga "Nonie" Schlee.

Following the move to the Eastern Shore in 1978, Ed, "Mr. Bob", and "Nonie", purchased Bob's Mini Mart in Queenstown, MD, and faithfully served their customers for 13 years.

Prior to joining the U.S. Navy during World War II and the Korean War, he had served in the U.S. Coast Guard.
