



## Edward John Bilinski

May 11, 1944 - July 27, 2025

Edward J. Bilinski, of St. Michael's MD, beloved husband, father, grandfather, friend and dogfather passed away on July 27, 2025.

Born on May 11, 1944, in Passaic, NJ, Ed grew in Bloomfield, NJ, where attended St. Valentine's school. He later attended Seton Hall Preparatory School in South Orange, NJ where he played football and wrestled.

Ed attended Notre Dame University and during his senior year met his wife Ellen Stewart Bilinski, a junior at Boston College, on a trip to Bermuda. He graduated that year with a BS in engineering and then served in Vietnam in 1967 with the 18th Engineer Brigade. While on R and R in Hawaii, he and Ellen were engaged and were married 57 years last April.

They have three daughters, Susan Carol Fine, Mary Katherine (Mimi) Bilinski and Stephanie Ellen Bilinski, and two sons in law, Barry Fine and Jason Bredice.

Ed received an MBA at NYU and started his career in the 1970s and 1980s at IBM. He later worked at Dun and Bradstreet, the American Stock Exchange, and retired in 2011 as the Senior VP of Infrastructure at Pearson PLC.

Ed was an avid private pilot and flew a Cirrus aircraft. He owned a judge yacht

and loved fishing and crabbing, which he learned to do at the New Jersey shore with his parents, Mary and John Bilinski, and spent many years doing the same with his granddaughter, Amanda (Mandy) Fine and his grandson, Steven Fine, who he loved immeasurably.

Ed will be remembered by his friends and family for his humor, intelligence, love for his family, his accordion playing, his volunteering at church, his parties, and as a man who could fix everything from broken hearts to the crack of dawn.

A funeral mass will be held on September 26th, 2025 at Saints Peter and Paul Roman Catholic Church at 11am.

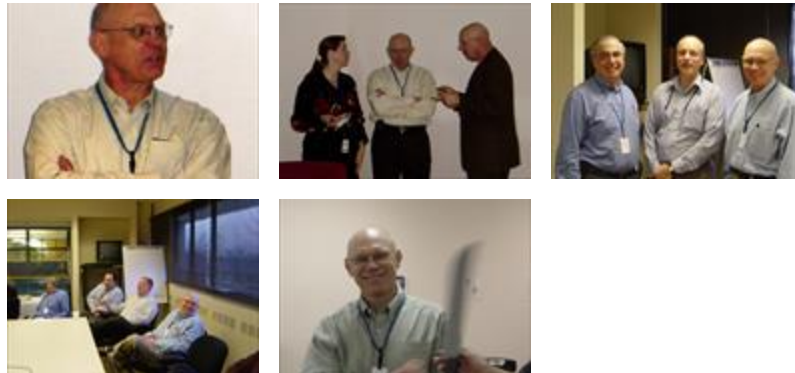
