Edward Lincoln Heller of Chestertown, MD died on Sunday, October 28, 2007 at Chester River Hospital. He was 95.

Born on February 12, 1912 in Newark, NJ, he was the son of the late, Ira S. and Mary Coyle Heller. Mr. Heller graduated from Lehigh University in 1934 and Harvard Business School in 1939. He served in the Quarter Master Corps of the US Army during WWII achieving the rank of Lt. Colonel. After the Second World War he went to work for the Joint Committee on Atomic Energy of the US Congress. Subsequent to his government service he worked for General Atomic and Gulf Oil Corporation primarily in the nuclear energy field. In 1978 he was nominated Assistant Inspector General for the US Department of Energy. He retired in 1982 and began working at the Smithsonian as a Fellow. Mr. Heller was also a lifelong boating enthusiast, he taught navigation courses for the United States Power Squadrons.

He was predeceased by his wife, Irene Heller on July 28, 2003.

Mr. Heller is survived by two sons, Peter D. Heller and his wife, Helen of Chestertown, MD, and Gregory E. Heller and his wife, Anne of Leawood, KS; six grandchildren as well as a goddaughter, Sister Philomena Fleck, O.S.B.

Services will be held at Greenwood Cemetery in Brooklyn, NY on November
