Edward Morris “Jim” Kennard of Chestertown, MD died Tuesday, July 26, 2005, in University of Maryland Hospital, Baltimore, MD. He was 81.

Born on July 16, 1924 in Chestertown, MD, he was the son of the late, Frank B. Kennard and Clara Latham Kennard Low.

Following graduation from Chestertown High School he served in the U.S. Navy during World War II in the European, American, and Pacific Theatres. He was honorably discharged in 1946 and returned to Chestertown. He worked as a truck driver with P.M. Brooks and Sons for many years hauling grain and also for Adkins Lumber Co. as a delivery driver. He retired from Adkins Lumber after many years.
