



## Edward Matthews Schmidt

March 24, 1933 - April 30, 2024

Dr. Edward Matthews Schmidt, a dedicated research scientist and beloved family man, peacefully departed this world on April 30, 2024, at the age of 91. Born on March 24, 1933, in Illinois, Ed's life was a testament to intellect, dedication, and boundless love.

Ed shared over six decades of companionship with his beloved wife, Marilyn, and together they raised two sons, John and his wife Cindy of Milton, Delaware, and Paul and his wife Kathy of Johnson City, Tennessee. Ed found immeasurable joy in the laughter of his grandchildren, Corinne and Jonathan, who brought light to his world. He was preceded in death by his cherished grandson, Carl, and his beloved sister, Carlene.

Educated with a Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering from Northwestern University (1956), followed by a Master of Science (1957) and a Ph.D. (1965) from Purdue University, Ed embarked on a career that left an indelible mark on scientific inquiry. As a research scientist at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) from February 1970 to May 1998, Ed's pioneering work in bioengineering, particularly in the field of visual prostheses, reshaped medical science. Even after retirement, his thirst for knowledge remained insatiable, evident in the numerous journal articles he continued to publish.

Beyond his professional pursuits, Ed found solace and joy in the simple

pleasures of life. An avid sailor, he delighted in navigating the waters of the Chesapeake Bay. Additionally, Ed had a deep appreciation for music, collecting antique music boxes as a hobby, each melody a cherished memory. For the last decade of his life, Ed resided in the serene surroundings of Londonderry. In his final years, he found comfort and contentment in the embrace of Londonderry, where his legacy of love and wisdom will forever endure. Marilyn, his devoted wife, now resides in Londonderry, surrounded by cherished memories of their life together.

A life celebration in honor of Ed's remarkable life will be held on May 23rd from 2-4pm at the Londonderry Clubhouse. 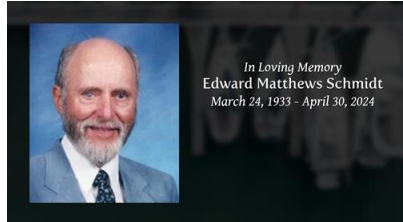
