Mr. Edward Collins Senseney died Saturday, September 9, 2006 at Arlington Hospital in VA. He was 74 years old.

Mr. Senseney was born on January 5, 1932 in Stevensville, MD, the son of Catherine Harkun and the late Charles Edward Senseney. Mr. Senseney was a graduate of Stevensville High School and would later attend St. Johns College in Annapolis. He would enlist in the Air Force and serve during the Korean War. While stationed in London he married Agnes Arnold. She would predecease him in 1985. After being honorably discharged they would return to Maryland and make their home in Hyattsville. Mr. Senseney graduated from the University of Maryland with a Bachelor of Science degree, and later attended graduate school for Sociology. He worked for twenty plus years with the federal government as a personnel specialist with the Department of the Navy, the Office of Economic Opportunity and the Department of Health and Human Services. He would later go to work for the State of Maryland with the Maryland National Planning and Park Commission. He would finish his career with Washington Bible College in Lanham, MD. Mr. Senseney moved to Stevensville in 1996, where he enjoyed watching football, talking history and traveling overseas.

Mr. Senseney is survived by his loving wife, Philomena C. Senseney of Stevensville, MD; his mother, Catherine Senseney of Easton, MD; two

daughters, Diane Sraver and her husband Tom of Timonium, MD, Lisa Thomas and her husband Sam of Baltimore, MD; a son, Charles Edward Senseney and his wife Elaine of Cockeysville, MD; six grand-children, Drew, Aimee, Cody, Joe, Matt and Elena.

A service will be held at 1:30 PM on Thursday, September 14, 2006 at Wye Bible Church in Grasonville, MD where family and friends will be received one hour prior. Internment will be private.
