Edward Jerry Spindler of Centreville, MD died Wednesday, May 10, 2006 at Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD. He was 75.

Born on August 9, 1930 in Washington, DC, the son of the late Mary Margaret Roche and Edward H. Spindler. Mr. Spindler attended the University of Maryland for two years before enlisting in the US Air Force. He served from 1951 to 1955. In 1991, he moved to Centreville, MD. Mr. Spindler enjoyed playing golf, fishing and walking his dogs.
