August 27, 1925 - February 21, 2012

Edward Worth Storke of Grasonville, MD, died on February 21, 2012. He was 86.

Mr. Storke was born in Mt. Rainier, MD, on August 27, 1925, and grew up in the Washington, DC, area. He served in the Army Air Corps during World War II in the Pacific. After receiving an Honorable Discharge in 1946, he attended Southeastern University in Washington, DC, and earned a Bachelor of Commercial Science degree. Mr. Storke then became a CPA and worked for a private accounting firm. He would later become Comptroller at Excavating Construction, Inc., based in Bladensburg, MD, where he worked for 25 years. He retired in 1996 and moved to the Eastern Shore to live in Prospect Bay.

Mr. Storke had a passion and love for the Chesapeake Bay, where he enjoyed boating with his wife, the former Betty Jean Dieffenbauch, to whom he was married for over 50 years. He enjoyed playing golf, croquet and pool. He was a member of the VFW Post 7464, the Bay Country Moose, and was on the Board of Trustees for the Community of Prospect Bay. He also assisted Mrs. Storke in her volunteer pet locator program.

In addition to his loving wife, Betty Jean, he is survived by his children, Sharon Zetts (Jon), Ronald Storke (Denise), Gordon Storke, and Debra Cave (John); 14 grandchildren; 15 great-grandchildren; and one great great-grandchild.
