



## Edward Wojcik

February 17, 1933 - May 31, 2015

Edward Wojcik of Church Hill, MD, died on May 31, 2015, at University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore, MD. He was 82.

He was born on February 17, 1933, the son of the late John and Anelia Wojcik. He was raised in Baltimore Highlands but spent most of his time residing in Dundalk.

Mr. Wojcik married Delia Porter on February 25, 1951 at the age of 18.

He was drafted into the U.S. Army and served a two-year term stateside during the Korean Conflict. He was honorably discharged on May 16, 1961.

Upon his return he worked for Shulte Ford which later became Bob Bell Ford as a Front End Mechanic. He retired in 1995.

In 2001, he and his wife moved to Queen Anne's County where he resided in Church Hill. He enjoyed collecting and restoring antique Buicks. He also enjoyed fishing, boating, and gardening.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by four sons, John E. Wojcik (Georgia) of Nags Head, NC, Chris A. Wojcik (Carol) of Pasadena, MD, Robert W. Wojcik (Debroah) of Pasadena, MD, and Edward G. Wojcik (Michelle) of Cordova,

MD; a daughter, Kathy L. Roe (Ronald W. Jr.) of Centreville, MD; ten grandchildren, Chris, Cara, Bob, Randi, Taylor, Joe, Ross, Cassandra, Alyssa, and Ashley; and four step-great grandchildren.

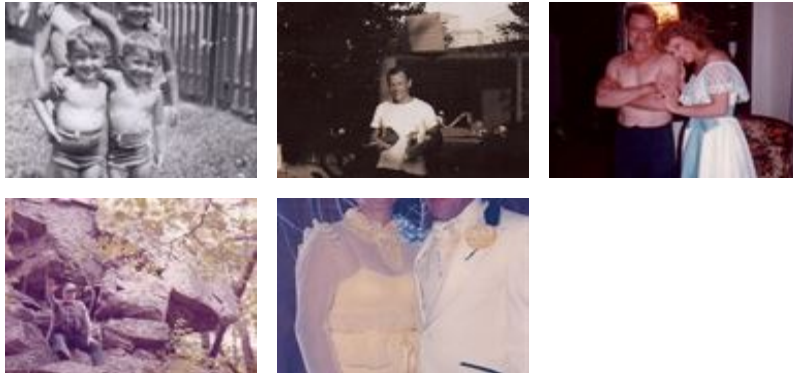
