



## Edward Andrews Biegel

Edward Andrews Biegel of Easton, MD died Monday, July 16, 2001 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 66.

Born in the Bronx, NY, February 19, 1935, he was the son of the late Edward and Doris Andrews Biegel. After the death of his father who served in WWII in Belgium, Ed and his mother returned to Easton to live with his grandmother. While attending Easton High School he began working as a clerk at the Easton Post office. Following his graduation from Easton High School in 1953 he remained with the Post office until 1955, when he entered the U.S. Army and served as a Sergeant in Korea where he was in charge of a military Post Office. Following his release from active duty, he returned to Easton to continue his career with the U.S. Postal Service, where he served as a supervisor and then promoted to Postmaster in Easton, then in Salisbury, MD and then Wilmington, DE. He was later promoted to a Manager in the Philadelphia region and later the Capitol Heights area of Southern Maryland. He retired in 1990 after 37 1/2 years of service.

He was a member of the Easton Elks Lodge #1622.

In October of 2000, Ed and the love of his life and soul mate, Mary Fleetwood, moved back to Easton. In addition he is survived by many relatives and friends.
