A Funeral Liturgy for Edward C. Bokman of Easton, MD will be celebrated at Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church in Easton on Monday, April 12, 2004 at 12:00 noon. Mr. Bokman died on Sunday, April 4, 2004 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 82.

Born April 21, 1921 in Baltimore, he was the son of the late Clifton Jerome and Kate Evans Bokman. After graduating from Baltimore City College in 1939, he worked for Montgomery Wards. He served in the U.S. Air Force during World War II. After his release from active duty in 1946, he took a position with Baltimore Gas & Electric where he remained until his retirement in the late 1970's.

A member of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church in Easton, Mr. Bokman was also a member of E.E. Streets Memorial Post 5118 V.F.W. and Baltimore Colt Corral 6 where he had served as President and Secretary. He loved to read and work crossword puzzles, was a stamp and coin collector and because of his love of airplanes, he loved living near the airport.

Mr. Bokman is survived by his wife, the former Betty Jean Higdon, whom he married October 9, 1944; a son, Edward Lawrence Bokman and his wife Beth of Eldersburg, MD; two sisters, Catherine Chittenden of Perry Hall and Mary Jane Dwyer of Arbutus; and two grandchildren, Amy Elizabeth Bokman and Andrew Lawrence Bokman. A brother, Francis Donald Bokman is deceased.
