



## Edward F. "Ted" Bennett

January 11, 1964 - July 25, 2008

Edward Franklin "Ted" Bennett of Easton, MD died on Friday, July 25, 2008. He was 44.

Born January 11, 1964 in Washington, D.C, Ted was adopted by Gordon and Marie Bennett in September 1964. He was welcomed in to the family by big brother Chuck, who was 5 years old at the time. with Norris Taylor Contractors where he worked with "Norry", whom he grew up with on the Miles River, doing concrete work for 17 years.
