Edward I. "Pete" Patchett, Jr. of Easton, MD died at his home on Thursday, January 31, 2002. He was 81.

Born July 1, 1920 in Bethlehem, MD, he was the son of the late Edward I., Sr. and Mary Brodes Patchett. After graduating from Preston High School in 1937 he served in the United States Army during WWII. Following his release from active duty, he joined the Maryland National Guard and worked at Prices Tire Shop in Easton, MD until forming Tire Retreaders, Inc. He retired in 1989.

In March of last year a Mayor's proclamation was presented to Mr. Patchett for his service as Supervisor of Elections for the Town of Easton since 1993.

He was member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton where he had served as head usher, served on the National Council of United American Mechanics for forty years, was a Boy Scout leader for thirty years, serving as coordinator for St. Mark's Boy Scout Troop #190 and a member of Easton Elks Lodge B.P.O. #1622

His wife, the former, Kathleen A. Kirwan whom he married December 22, 1940, died January 19, 2001.

Mr. Patchett is survived by a daughter, Phyllis K. Peddicord of Preston; a son,

Edward I. Patchett III, of Ocean City; four grandchildren and three great grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, February 5, 2002 at 11:00 AM at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Easton. Friends may call on Monday, February 4, 2002 from 7 to 9 PM at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton.
