: Edward James “Jimmy” Cain of Easton, MD died on Monday, November 8, 2004 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton, MD. He was 65.

Born July 4, 1939 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late John Edward and Jennie Mazur Cain. Following his graduation from Baltimore Polytechnic High School he served in the United States Navy in the Seabees from August 1956 until July 1960 and then attended Johns Hopkins University. His lifelong career dealt with surveying and engineering in Baltimore County. Following his retirement he worked as a consultant with the State of Maryland on the Eastern Shore.

He was a member of the V.F.W. Memorial Post # 7937, Denton, MD.

His first wife, the former Mildred Henry Cain died in 2000.

Mr. Cain is survived by his second wife, Elaine Jepson Krauth whom he married November 16, 2002; a sister, Gloria Cain Cerino of Baltimore and several nieces and nephews. He was also pre-deceased by a sister, Frances M. Jerns.

Graveside services will be held on Saturday, November 13, 2004 at Holy Rosary Cemetery, German Hill Road, Dundalk, MD at 10:30 AM.
