January 10, 1936 - February 8, 2010

Edward Michael “Ed” Sullivan died on February 8, 2010 at his home in Centreville, Maryland after a short illness at the age of 74.

Born on January 10, 1936 in Philadelphia, PA to Michael and Mary Olexa Sullivan, Ed graduated from LaSalle University, Magna Cum Laude, with a BS in Accounting in 1957 and was commissioned as a 1st Lieutenant in the US Army at Ft. Sill, OK in 1958. Following his tour, he returned to Philadelphia and received his MBA from Temple University in 1968.

Ed lived most of his life in Bucks County, PA working as a CPA in the Philadelphia area. He moved to MD’s Eastern Shore in 2000 where he could enjoy the water and his love of boating. He continued working as a CPA as a consultant until his death. His fondness of automobiles was evident with the many vehicles that he owned over the years. He would affectionately name each one of them – The Green Hornet, The Silver Bullet, The Bat and The Copper Whopper.

Truly a man “young at heart,” Ed enjoyed meeting up with his many friends on Kent Island, having his annual Fourth of July and Super Bowl parties and was a die-hard Eagles fan. At home his time was spent reading hardback spy novels, working in his office, watching football, communicating with friends on his laptop, enjoying time with his neighbors, planning outings, and seeking fine dining venues.

Ed is survived by his wife, Elena, his four children; Cynthia McKelvey of Ellicott City, Kevin Sullivan of Cornelius, NC, Stephen Sullivan of San Diego, CA, Cynthia Christine Tollok of New Hope, PA ; five grandchildren; one great grandson; and a sister, Rosemary Kelly and her husband, Bill, of Bristol, PA.

A Mass will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, February 11, 2010 at St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church, 5319 Ocean Gateway, Queenstown, Maryland. Following the Mass, friends and family will gather for a celebration of Ed's life at the Clubhouse at Symphony Village in Centreville.
