



Edward Paul Martuszewski

September 13, 1927 - November 16, 2010

Edward Paul Martuszewski of Chestertown, MD died on Tuesday, November 16, 2010 at his home. He was 83.

He was born on September 13, 1927, the son of the late, Paul and Justina Jusck Martuszewski. In 1953, Mr. Martuszewski married Regina Elizabeth Bertrand. He served in the U.S. Army serving two terms totaling nearly five years. He earned an occupation medal in Japan and a Korean service medal with a Bronze star. Mr. Martuszewski was honorably discharged in June of 1952. He then returned to Curtis Bay in Baltimore where he worked at Harbinson Walker Refractories in Brooklyn, MD for 33 years, retiring in 1986. He and his wife moved to Chestertown in 1985.

Mr. Martuszewski was a handyman, able to make or remodel anything from a full size van, which he upgraded and traveled extensively, to any repairs or additions to their home. He was a member of St. Anthanasius Catholic Church, and a member of the breakfast group at Dunkin Donuts, where many of the world's problems were allegedly solved.

Mr. Martuszewski is survived by his wife, Regina Martuszewski of Chestertown, MD; a daughter, Terrie McKenzie of Chestertown, MD; a granddaughter, Kristen Roberts of Chestertown, MD; three sisters, Elizabeth Kluga of Dundalk, MD, Toni Borkoski of Curtis Bay, MD and Dorothy Quasney

of Chestertown, MD.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, November 19, 2010 at 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. Chestertown, MD. A visitation will be held on Thursday, November 18, 2010 from 2:00–4:00 PM, from 6:00–8:00 PM and one hour prior to the service on Friday at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 130 Speer Road, Chestertown, MD 21620.

Interment will be in Maryland Veterans Cemetery in Hurlock, MD.
