Edward R. Sheppard, 67, a resident of Southwind on Kent Island, died at home on Thursday, May 31, after a brief illness.

Mr. Sheppard was born in Haleyville, New Jersey. He obtained a B.A. degree in economics and an M.B.A. from Rutgers University, where he was a member of the Chi Phi Fraternity. He was a veteran of the United States Marine Corps.

During his career Mr. Sheppard worked for the Prudential Insurance Company, McGraw-Hill Publishing Company, and Chilton Publishing. He retired in 1992 from the Kiplinger Washington Editors, where he was the Vice President of Operations.

While working in Washington, Mr. Sheppard served as Chairman of the Membership and Allocations Committee for the United Way, National Capital Area, as well as administrator of the Kiplinger Charitable Trust Foundation. He belonged to the Kent Island Yacht Club, was an active member of Galilee Lutheran Church, and volunteered at the Wildfowl Trust of North America. Mr. Sheppard was a World War II history buff. His other interests included traveling, duplicate bridge, reading, gardening, cooking, and eating out.

Mr. Sheppard is survived by his wife, Sylvia Sheppard; two children, David Allen Sheppard and Diane Sheppard Brown; four grandchildren; a brother,

Charles Sheppard; and a sister, Edith Taylor.

A memorial celebration of Ed Sheppard's life will be held at Galilee Lutheran Church, 1934 Harbor Drive, Chester, on Wednesday, June 6, at 11 a.m.
