Edward Tarman Hugler of Galena, Md. died Tuesday, June 12, 2001 at his home. He was 80.

Edward T. Hugler was born July 16, 1920 in Philadelphia, Pa., the son of the late Harry and Hazel Tarman Hugler. A 1943 graduate of Drexel Institute of Technology in Philadelphia, Pa., Mr. Hugler was a veteran of 42 years of federal service in Washington, D.C., including 14 years as an investigator for the House Post Office-Civil Service Committee. Mr. Hugler retired in 1986 and later moved to the eastern shore where he has resided since. He was an avid fisherman who most enjoyed fishing on the Chesapeake Bay, and in retirement fishing on the Sassafras River. Mr. Hugler was also a member of the Gregg Neck Yacht Club. He was a lifetime fan of the Orioles and Redskins.

He is survived by his wife Lavina R. Hugler of Langley Park, Md., 3 sons, Ed Hugler of McLean, Va., James Hugler of Bowie, Md., and Will Hugler of Galena, Md. He is also survived by two grandchildren who loved him dearly Sam and Sarah Hugler both of McLean, Va.
