2017 at the age of 76. He is survived by his children, Jared, Erika, Bronwyn & Jayson Fulton, 2 grandchildren Ayden & Adelle Fulton, and his loving partner Deborah Taylor. He was a respected Orthopedic Surgeon, Founder of Bay Area Orthopedics group, and a decorated Vietnam War Veteran.
