



Edwin R. Jefferson

May 21, 1925 - May 26, 2017

Edwin “Eddie” Russell Jefferson, Jr., 92, of Easton, MD, died peacefully on Friday, May 26, 2017 at his home. He was born in Easton on May 21, 1925, son of the late Edwin Russell Jefferson, Sr., and Florence Alice Marshall.

Mr. Jefferson graduated from Easton High School. He served proudly in the United States Army, during World War II, from 1943-1945. He was a member of the 17th Airborne Division #513, Parachute Infantry Regiment Company H. He was part of the German Invasion of the Rhine River Valley. While serving his country, he was wounded in action and received The Purple Heart and Bronze Star. He was employed for over 30 years with A&P Supermarkets and SuperFresh, retiring as a Manager in 1986. He was the last living charter member of the VFW EE Streets Memorial Post #5118 in Easton. He served in the Honor Guard for many years. He was also a member of the Easton Elks Lodge #1622.

He is survived by his wife of 33 years, Suzanne S. Jefferson; a son, Edwin R. “Rusty” Jefferson, III, and his wife Barb; four daughters, Denise Griffith and her husband James, Chris Effinger, Sandy Durham, and Patricia Marcian and her husband Dave; a stepson, Michael Granger; 11 grandchildren: Eddie, Bryan, Matt, Cody, Olivia, Christine, Craig, Adam, Emily, Ethan and Cameron; and nine great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his first wife, Adele C. Callahan-Jefferson, who died in 1972.

A funeral liturgy will be celebrated at 11:00 A.M. on Thursday, June 1, 2017 at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church, 1210 S. Washington St. in Easton. Burial with military honors will follow in Woodlawn Memorial Park on Rt. 50 near Easton.
