Edwin "Jay" John Sadowski, Jr., 59, from Chester, MD, passed away Saturday, October 4, after a year-long battle with Leukemia.

He was born November 24, 1954, to the late Edwin and Berkley Sadowski and grew up in Cape St. Claire. He attended St. Mary's Parish and graduated from Severna Park High in 1972. Jay was a business owner and certified auto technician for Auto Sport in Annapolis, MD. He was past president of his community association, coached KI baseball leagues for many years and was also a past leader of the Cub Scouts.

He was a charter member of the Broadneck Elks, the American Legion, NRA, and DU.

Jay is survived by his wife, Laura; daughter, Christine and son-in-law Brian Habeck; son, Kyle; grandsons, Jackson and Tyler; and his sister, Robin.

Spending time with his family and grandchildren were the highlight of his life along with hunting, fishing, riding his many Harleys and going to many of the Ravens and Orioles home games.

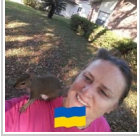
