



Edwin Girard Van Schaik

Edwin Girard Van Schaik passed away peacefully on January 14, 2016, at Homestead Manor in Denton, MD. He was 89.

Born on July 23, 1926, in Lodi, NJ, he was the son of the late John and Anna Reckenbale Van Schaik.

Edwin served in the U.S. Army during World War II and was honorably discharged in August 1946. He married the former Vera Cox on March 1, 1957, and they resided in Easton.
