



## Edwin Roy Sullivan, Sr.

October 10, 1917 - May 27, 2011

TRAPPE: Edwin Roy Sullivan, Sr., of Trappe, died at the William Hill Manor on May 27, 2011. He was 93.

Born in Trappe, October 10, 1917, he was the son of the late Edwin J. and Ruth Miller Sullivan. A 1935 graduate of the Trappe High School, he served in the United States Army Air Corps in the European Theater of Operations during World War II. Following his release from active duty, he worked as a pipe fitter with the Local #74 of the Pipefitters and Plumbers Union in Wilmington, DE. He retired in 1982.

He was a resident of Wilmington, DE until moving to Trappe in 1982, and a member of the Trappe United Methodist Church.

Mr. Sullivan is survived by his wife, the former Gladys R. Flint whom he married in Biloxi, MS in April of 1943; a son, Edwin Roy Sullivan, Jr. of Frederick, MD, his spouse Lois Benjamin, a sister, Lois R. Benson of Milford, DE and two grandchildren Amy Sullivan of Charlotte, NC and Jill Sullivan Weaver of Raleigh, NC.

Funeral services will be held on Wed. June 1 at 11 a.m. at Trappe United Methodist Church.

Burial will be at the Oxford Cemetery, Oxford, MD
