



Effie Gernert Jones

August 20, 1923 - October 5, 2014

Effie Gernert Jones, 91, of Centreville, MD, died on October 5, 2014, at Corsica Hills Nursing Home, surrounded by her family.

Born in Baltimore, MD, on August 20, 1923, she was the daughter of the late James and Bessie Viola Myers Callahan, and the wife of Roland H. Gernert until his death in 1970. She graduated from Western High School in Baltimore in the Class of 1940, and worked as a receptionist and payroll clerk with the Social Security Administration until 1960.

She left work to become a homemaker in Chester for 11 years, and later returned to work in real estate with Century 21 Tideland Properties in Easton, MD, for 20 years, during which time she resided in Wye Mills, MD. Ms. Jones retired from real estate in 1992, and worked for Corsica Hills as a receptionist.

She was a member of Wye Mills United Methodist Church, worked with the Queen Anne's County Office on Aging Center for 20 years, and was a member of the Women of the Moose of Queenstown, MD.

Ms. Jones is survived by her children, Martin Garrett of Orville, AL, Sue Thom of Centreville, MD, Peggy Lane of Centreville, MD, Roland Gernert of Lewis, DE, and James Gernert of Baltimore, MD; and many grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

A funeral service will be held at 11 a.m. on Friday, October 10 at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Centreville, MD, where friends and family may visit on Thursday from 6-8 p.m.

Burial will follow at Woodlawn Memorial Park in Easton, MD.
