E. Franklin Foreman of Easton died on Sunday, January 31, 2010 at Genesis Health Care the Pines. He was 85.

Born in Easton on April 14, 1924, he was the son of the late, Clifford F. and Mabel Joseph Foreman. A lifelong resident of Talbot County, he worked his entire lifetime as a farmer until retiring in 1986. He had resided on the family farm, The Golton Farm, near Easton, since 1954.

A former member of the Talbot County Farm Bureau, he was also a member of the Eastern Shore Fox Hunters Association, Inc.

Mr. Foreman is survived by his wife, the former Edith M. Daubach, whom he married in December of 1945; a daughter, Janet M. Golt of Easton; six sons, Ronald L. Foreman of Delmar, Ernest F.
