



Eileen Ruth Gittins

March 31, 1933 - November 30, 2023

Eileen Ruth Gittins of Stevensville, MD passed away on November 30, 2023. She was 90 years old.

Born on March 31, 1933, in Maple Shade, NJ, she was the daughter of the late Michael J. Maher and Julia F. Maher.

Eileen graduated from Moorestown High School and worked as a secretary for the Campbell Soup Co. While on vacation in the Poconos, she met Donald J. Gittins. He was so enamored, he called her as soon as she returned home from vacation, and he made the trip to New Jersey to see her every weekend. On February 12, 1955, they were married forming a strong and loving partnership that lasted until Donald's death in 1993. The couple made their home on Long Island, and then in Cape St. Claire, where they raised their family for over 20 years before moving to Kent Island in 2003.

Eileen was a passionate advocate in the State Legislature for people who suffered from brain injuries. Her work contributed to the passing of the helmet laws in Maryland. In her free time, she enjoyed going to the movies, cooking, visiting various beaches and lighthouses, and volunteering at Anne Arundel Medical Center. She will be remembered as a kind person and a good friend.

Eileen is survived by her daughter, Susan Fowler Schatz and her husband,

Chuck; a son, James Gittins; a daughter in-law, Patty Gittins; grandchildren: Andrew Fowler, Jaime Fowler (Caleb), Matthew Gittins (April), and Kyle Gittins (Samantha); and great grandchildren, Holden Fowler and Adelyn Gittins. In addition to her parents, she is predeceased by her husband, Donald James Gittins; son, Donald William Gittins; sister, Dorothy Farren and her companion of 15 years, Bill Jones.
