



Eileen G. Marshall

August 27, 1917 - September 23, 2008

Eileen Guinee Marshall, who spent most of her 91 years in Pottstown, PA died on September 23, 2008 at Heron Point in Chestertown, MD after a short illness. Eileen was one of seven children, only three of whom survived childhood. She was very possibly the first lay teacher at St. Aloysius School. In September of 1953, her son Bill was enrolled in the first grade, one of over ninety students with a single Franciscan nun as their teacher. It was suggested that since she was a college graduate (Immaculata, 1939) perhaps she could step in and help “temporarily.” The “temporary” grew to a long career as a fourth grade teacher and, later, as librarian at St. Pius X High School. She was the first woman Explorer advisor in the Boy Scouts of Valley Forge Council. Post 249’s primary activity was scuba diving, and Eileen was the primary instructor.

She loved needlework, was a formidable bridge player, incessant reader of crime fiction, a wonderful mother and a dedicated wife.

In addition to her husband, P. William (Bill) Marshall who predeceased her in 2007, she is predeceased by a son, William.

She is survived by a son, Paul of Sudbury, MA; three grandchildren, Bridget of Lowell, MA, Brendan of Germantown, MD, and Elizabeth of Wellington, New Zealand. Eileen’s greatest delight this past year was the birth of her great

granddaughter, Lucy.
